Resolution ____ of 2013: Adopting West Wyoming 2014 Tax Rate

A Resolution summarizing expenditures and revenues for each fund and adopting a budget for the West Wyoming Borough, Pennsylvania for the calendar year beginning on the first day of January, 2014, and ending on the last day of December, 2014.

WHEREAS, the council of West Wyoming Borough has appointed the finance committee of West Wyoming Borough to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said council.

and

WHEREAS, the finance committee of West Wyoming Borough Council has submitted a proposed budget to this governing body on November 11, 2013, for its consideration, and;

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published or posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held on November 11, 2013, and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget.

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues or planned to be expended from reserves/fund balances so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE of the West Wyoming Borough Council,

Section 1. That the budget as submitted, amended, and summarized by fund, hereby is approved and adopted as the budget of the West Wyoming Borough for the year stated above with a property tax rate fixed at 1.5 mils.

Section 2. That the budget hereby approved and adopted shall be signed by West Wyoming Borough Council Chairman and made a part of the public records of the West Wyoming Borough ADOPTED, December, 9, 2013.
