

WEST WYOMING BOROUGH ORDINANCE NUMBER 2016.1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING AMENDING ALL ORDINANCES WHICH REQUIRE ENFORCEMENT OF VIOLATIONS

West Wyoming Borough Council, having identified ordinances of West Wyoming Borough which require enforcement of penalties for violations, to include, but not limited to, warnings and citations, and West Wyoming Borough Council desires that all ordinances provide authority and power to the following to enforce such ordinances namely, the police, the code enforcement officer and any other designated person or persons by Borough Council hereby amends all Ordinances in West Wyoming Borough as follows:

Now, therefore be it enacted and Ordained by the Borough Council of West Wyoming as follows:

Section 1. Enforcement of All Ordinances to be carried out by police and/or code enforcement officer and/or designated person or persons by Borough Council.

Where provisions exist in each and every ordinance for violations and penalties it is heretofore amended that all ordinances shall include that enforcement of the ordinances are to be accomplished by West Wyoming police officers and/or West Wyoming code enforcement officer and/or designated person or persons by West Wyoming Borough Council or West Wyoming Borough Council Chairman.

Section 2. Severability.

If any part of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby.


Section 3. Repealer.
