

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AMENDMENT OF JULY 8, 1974, TO THE CURFEW ORDINANCE OF OCTOBER 2, 1964, WHICH AMENDMENT INCREASES TO EIGHTEEN YEARS THE MAXIMUM AGE OF THE PERSONS TO WHICH IT APPLIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Borough of West Wyoming, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania and is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

The Ordinance of July 8, 1974 which provides for a curfew is hereby amended as follows:


SECTION I: That portion of SECTION I which reads "sixteen years" is amended to read eighteen years.

SECTION II: That portion of SECTION II which reads "sixteen years" is amended to read eighteen years.

SECTION III: The intent and purpose of this Ordinance is to reinstate in all respects all of the original provisions contained in the Curfew Ordinance of October 2, 1964.
