

Ordinance No. 1-2014

An ordinance of the Borough of West Wyoming, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, establishing stop signs at the corner of Washington Avenue and Lackawanna Avenue, and establishing penalties for violations.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING aforesaid, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: All vehicular traffic coming from Washington Avenue to Lackawanna Avenue and from Lackawanna Avenue to Washington Avenue shall come to a complete stop, prior to proceeding, upon reaching the intersection of the said Washington and Lackawanna Avenues.

SECTION 2: Any person guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be subject to pay a fine. In cases where the matter comes before a District Magistrate for adjudication, the Magistrate is authorized to impose his costs in addition to the said fine.
