## BULK PICK UP

There will also be a BULK ITEM pick-up on **Monday, April 16** which is limited to two bulk item per household. Residents may not put out any building materials, ammunition, electronics, car parts or tires, or any hazardous type waste. For items containing Freon, the Freon must be extracted and a certificate stating so from a licensed refrigeration expert must be taped to the item. Freon items include: air conditioners, refrigerators, etc. Residents could place boxes containing various items so long as they do not exceed a five foot cubic area.

## Yard Waste Collection

The yard waste program for West Wyoming residents will begin on Thursday, **April 5** for residents living in the Atherton Park section up to but NOT including 8th St. Residents, living on 8th Street up to the Exeter Line will have their scheduled pick-up on Thursday, **April 12**. Thereafter, yard waste will be picked up on alternating Thursdays. Residents are reminded to place yard waste out the night before in open containers and also to bundle and tie any bushes, hedges, or small trees in three foot lengths. Yard waste containers should not exceed 30lbs. No plastic or recyclable bags, no stones or dirt allowed. Compost Yard will be open Saturdays starting **April 7**.



**Recycling** Containers are located behind Hose Company #1. Recycling can be dropped off any day of the week. The borough accept newspaper, magazines, office paper, books, cardboard and commingled items. The borough is encouraging

residents to recycle. The following is the list of acceptable items for recycling. Commingled Food and Beverage Containers, #1 & #2 Plastic Containers. Please no plastic sheets or packing materials. Please empty and rinse bottles. Aluminum, tin, and food service cans. No foil or aluminum tray. Glass bottles and jars (no lids). Please no windshields, window glass, dinnerware or ceramics. Newspaper, Magazines, and Office Paper Recycling includes newspapers and everything delivered with it – including inserts, coupons, etc. All clean and dry paper including: office paper and shredded paper, magazines, junk mail, phone books, writing paper (all colors), computer paper, Xerox paper, catalogs, and brochures. Cardboard Containers include corrugated cardboard boxes, cereal boxes, cake boxes. Please flatten or cut boxes.
