Snow Emergency Parking

West Wyoming Borough Council would like to remind residents of the Snow Emergency Parking Ban Ordinance. This ordinance requires that residents remove their cars from street parking to off street parking during snowstorms. This will allow the borough street department better access to clear the roads. When the ban is in effect, it will be announced on local TV stations.

Sanitation Stickers/Recycling

Sanitation stickers are now on sale at the Town Hall, weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. If purchased from February 1-28, 2012, the cost is \$200. After February 28, 2012, the cost will be \$300 for the year and citations will be filed with the District Magistrate for noncompliance with the Ordinance.
