## Bulk Item Pickup Information

West Wyoming Borough will have a bulk item pick-up on Monday, October 15. The pickup is limited to two bulk items per household. Residents may not put out any building materials, ammunition, electronics, car parts or tires or any hazardous type waste. For items containing Freon, the Freon must be extracted and a certificate stating so from a licensed refrigeration expert must be taped to the item. Freon items include air conditioners, refrigerators, etc.

## We Want You!!!

West Wyoming Borough Council seeks a borough high school student interested in becoming a Junior Council Person (JCP). The Junior Council Program was established and fostered by the Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs (PSAB), and seeks to encourage high school age borough residents to participate in the workings of their local government by becoming a Junior Council Person. The borough is looking for a student to serve a 2 year term as a representative of the youth of the municipality to bring forth issues and information from their prospective.

Candidates for the office shall submit a written application to Borough Council with a one-page cover letter highlighting the applicant's interest in the position, by November 1. After considering all submissions, Borough Council shall appoint a student at a regularly scheduled meeting.

- The Junior Council Person shall be a resident of West Wyoming Borough and a student in his/her junior year of high school.
- The Junior Council Person shall be sworn in upon appointment and take an "oath of office."
- The Junior Council Person shall not receive compensation.
- The Junior Council Person shall be permitted to attend all meetings of Council and shall be permitted to participate fully in those proceedings, **EXCEPT** that he/she shall not be afforded the right to vote and shall not be permitted to attend executive sessions.

## Sanitation Stickers

Sanitation stickers will be on sale beginning in November at the Town Hall, weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. All residences in West Wyoming must purchase a sticker. The cost remains the same as last year, \$200. If purchased before January 31, 2012, senior citizens (65 and older) will receive a \$25 rebate (\$175), all others receive a \$15 rebate (\$185). If purchased from February 1-28, 2012, the full price will be charged, \$200. After February 28, 2012, the cost will be \$300 for the year and citations will be filed with the District Magistrate for noncompliance with the Ordinance. Stickers are also available through the mail: West Wyoming Borough Building, 464 West 8<sup>th</sup> Street, P.O. Box 4035, 464 West 8<sup>th</sup> Street, West Wyoming PA 18644. For the added convenience of residents, Visa, MasterCard and Mac are accepted

Payments for the borough sanitation stickers and sewer user fees can now be made through the website [www.westwyoming.org](http://www.westwyoming.org). A convenience fee will be added to the sanitation sticker fee.
