SHOEMAKER AVENUE (S.R.1010)AND EIGHTH STREET (S.R.1021)


WHEREAS, there have been a number of residents complaining that traffic leaving the mini-
mart at the corner of Shoemaker Ave. and Eighth Street in West Wyoming has no traffic signal
phase; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Borough of West Wyoming is concerned for the safety of all
motorists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the West Wyoming Council works to promote and provide safe traffic conditions
throughout the borough;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that on the 12th day of June, 2004 the Council for the

Transportation (PENNDOT) to make timing changes to the traffic signals at the intersection of
Shoemaker (S.R.1010) and Eighth Street (S.R.1021) to govern the traffic entering and exiting the
mini mart at said location.


