

WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE NO. 6 OF 2003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING TO CHARGE THE INTERSECTION OF EVERGREEN AND STITES STREETS TO REQUIRE A FOUR WAY STOP SIGN

WHEREAS, the West Wyoming Borough Council desires to make West Wyoming a safe place and control traffic, this ordinance will make the intersection of Evergreen and Stites Streets an area designated and traffic controlled by a Four Way Stop Sign.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and Ordained by the Borough Council of West Wyoming as follows:

Section I: Four Way Stop Sign at Evergreen and Stites Streets

The intersection of Evergreen and Stites Streets shall have Stop Signs erected at all four corners. All motorists shall obey the traffic signs in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Failure to abide by the law will result in a citation and traffic fines in accordance with previously established fines.

Section II: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any part of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby.

Section III: Repealer: All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
