WEST WYOMING ORDINANCE NUMBER _5-2005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING SETTING FORTH SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING BAN

WHEREAS: The Borough of West Wyoming and its Council desires to keep the streets and sidewalks passable during the winter season enacts the following parking ban.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of the Borough of West Wyoming and it is hereby ordained by the authority of same:

Section I: Definitions

The following words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings given to them in this section and unless the context clearly indicated otherwise:

"Borough" The Borough of West Wyoming

Winter Season" That period from November 1st to April 30th and any other time a winter or ice storm may occur.

Section II: Winter Storm Emergency Parking Restrictions

General Rule: Upon the declaration of a snow emergency by the Borough Council or its designee, i.e. Public Works and Street Department, no person shall stop, stand, park or leave any vehicle or permit it to stand upon any street or highway which has been designated as a "no parking snow emergency street". Streets shall be designated by West Wyoming Council. The council or its designee shall give notice of the imposition of the parking restrictions to the press, radio or television winter storm announcements regarding parking bans.

The ban may be rescinded by the Council if the snowplowing has been accomplished or the ban no longer is necessary. The ban requires all vehicles to be removed from street parking to off-street parking or for vehicles to be parked where no ban is in effect.

Section III. Penalties for Violation of Parking Ban

Violation of the parking ban will result in a parking ticket issued by the police. The parking ticket amount will be in accordance with the prevailing fines for other parking violations. Violations may result in towing vehicles in violation of the ban if deemed necessary by the police department.

Section IV: Severability

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provision shall be unaffected thereby.

Section V: Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
