

ORDINANCE NUMBER 4 of 2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST WYOMING CHANGING PORTIONS OF TWO WAY STREETS TO ONE WAY STREETS AND ONE WAY STREETS TO TWO WAY STREETS DURING THE SR1010 SHOEMAKER AVENUE PENNDOT BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS: The Borough of West Wyoming and its Council desires to ensure the PennDOT 1010 Shoemaker Avenue Bridge Replacement Project (heretofore referred to as the "PennDOT Project") is safely completed and for the ease of traffic flow and safety of the residents in West Wyoming borough the following streets shall be changed for the duration of the PennDOT project which starts in late spring of 2015

WHEREAS, Tripp Street is currently a two way street between Morgan Street and Ensign Street, Tripp Street shall become a one way street between Morgan and Ensign Streets during the duration of the PennDOT Project; and

WHEREAS, Ensign Street is a two way street it shall become a one way street as traffic flows onto Eighth Street for the duration of the PennDOT Project; and

WHEREAS, E. Sperling Street is a one way street, E. Sperling Street shall become a two way Street between Ensign Street and Shoemaker Avenue for the duration of the PennDOT Project; and

WHEREAS, Holden Street is a one way street from Ensign to Shoemaker Ave, Holden Street shall become two way from Ensign to the back entrance of the Borough parking lot for the duration of the PennDOT project; and

WHEREAS, no parking will be allowed on E. Sperling and Ensign Streets for the duration of the PennDOT Project; and

WHEREAS, traffic through the alternate route will be limited to local traffic and emergency vehicles only for the duration of the PennDOT Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the West Wyoming Borough Council by the authority of same as follows:

Section I:

The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference.

Section II:

All provisions of previous ordinances of the Borough of West Wyoming, or parts thereof, which are contrary or inconsistent to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

Section III.

In all other respects, the streets and parking regulations of the Borough of West Wyoming shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.


Section IV:


